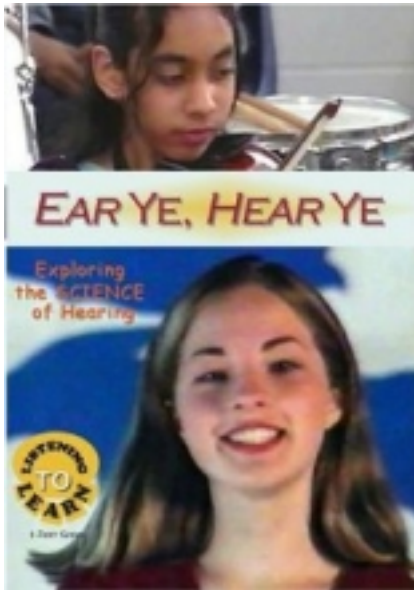


## Ear Ye, Hear Ye: Exploring the Science of Hearing
