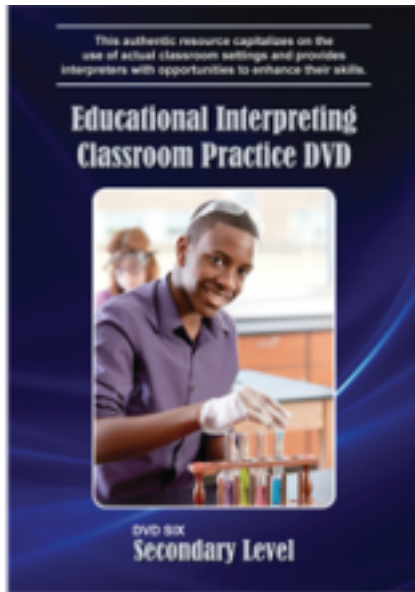


Educational Interpreting Practice DVD 6: Secondary Level
