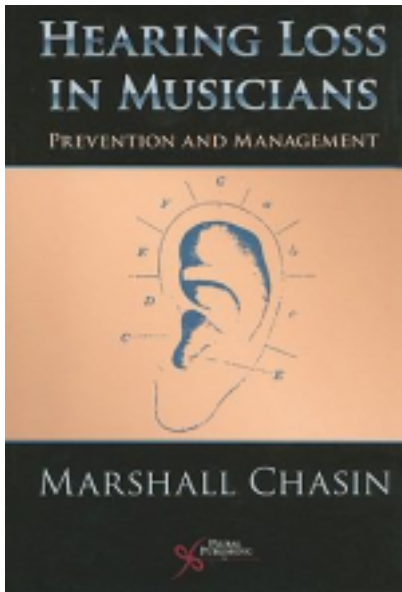


Hearing Loss in Musicians: Prevention and Management
