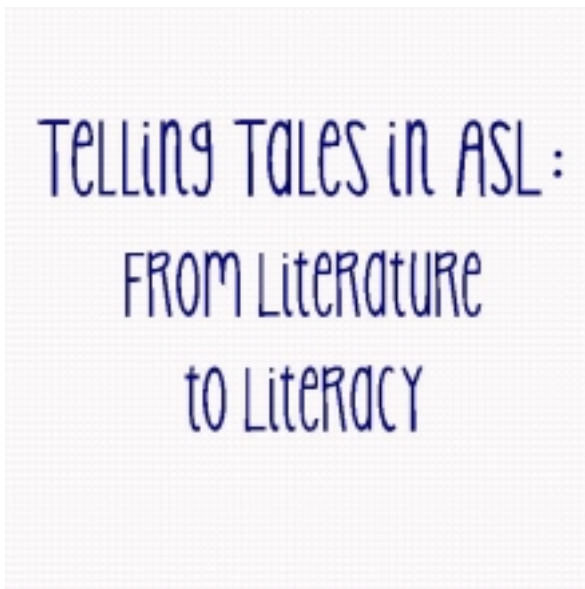


Telling Tales in ASL: From Literature to Literacy
