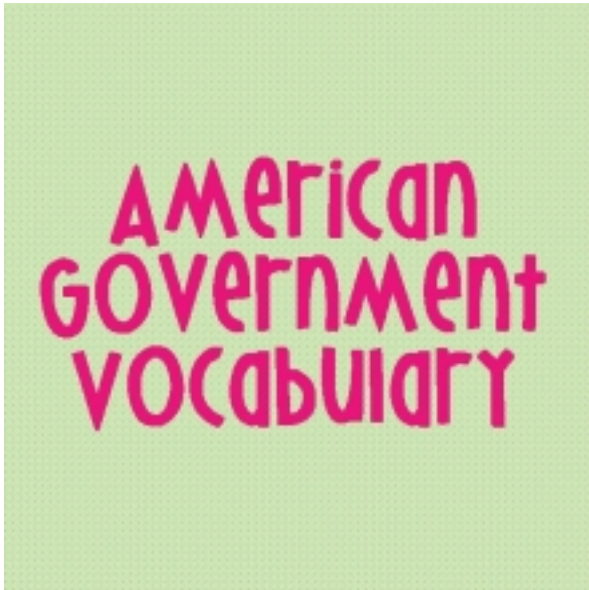


American Government Vocabulary
