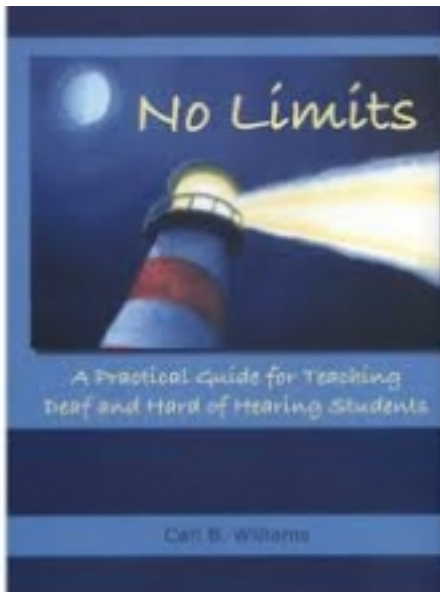


No Limits: A Practical Guide for Teaching Deaf and Hard of Hearing Students
