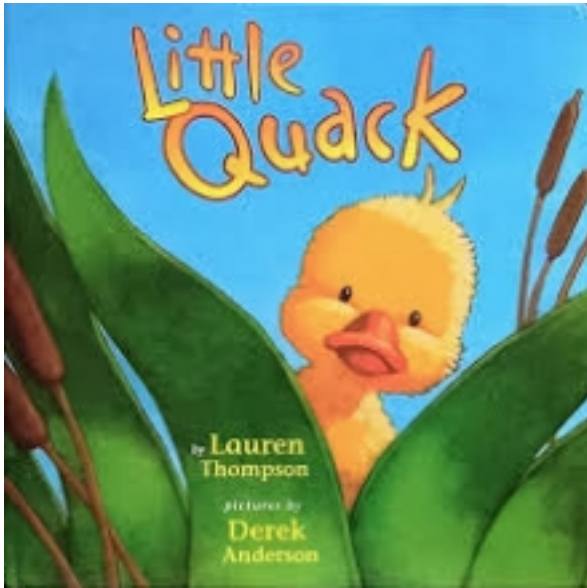




Little Quack
