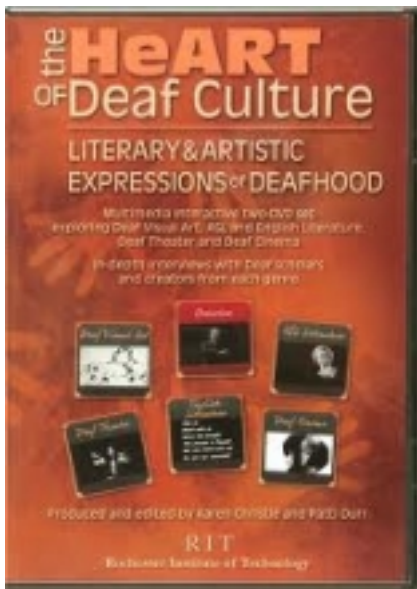


The HeART of Deaf Culture: Literary & Artistic Expressions of Deafhood
