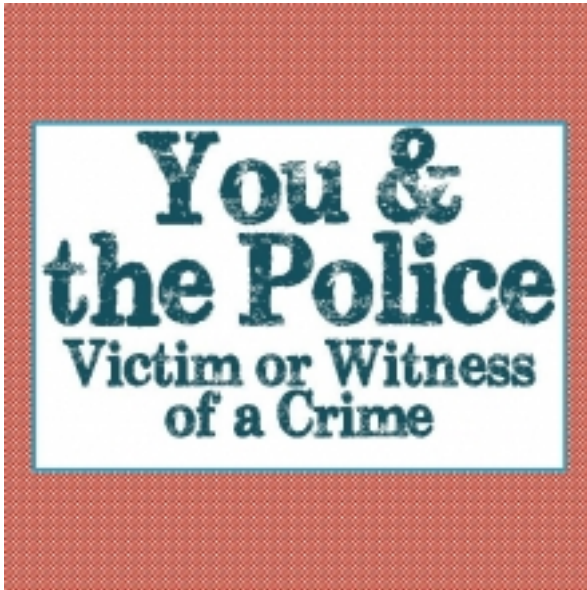




## You and the Police: Victim or Witness of a Crime
