Standards **Schools:** EIPA 3.5+

**Licensure:** Yes for educational interpreters

**Website(s):** [Assignment of Persons Providing Sign Language Interpreting for Students who are Deaf and Hard of Hearing](#) [1]

**CEUs:** 12 hours annually

**Special Provisions:** Substitute educational interpreters must have EIPA 3.5+ if working for more than 35 consecutive days. If an educational interpreter has a EIPA 2.5+, they have 3 years to raise their skill to 3.5+.
