Description Of Services:

CAMP RISE AND SIGN:

May 10-12, 2019

An annual sleep-away just for our Deaf and hard of hearing students, it's an adventure filled with all the great camp traditions--sleeping bags, campfires, arts & crafts, and fireflies. FREE.

CAMP SIGN ME UP:

June 3 - July 19, 2019

A weekly, summer camp in which hearing friends and family learn American Sign Language (ASL) and practice during field trips and special activities.

Campers are welcome to attend more than one week. Activities will change each week. Camp is \$85 per week for your first child, and there is a \$10 discount for siblings.

Camps starts at 9:00am and ends at 3:30pm. Before and after care, 8:30am to 4:45pm, are offered for \$40.00 per week.

If you have more than one camper, please complete a separate form for each child.

Schedule:**June 3-7 | Teen Week (age: 13-17)**

This intensive week is for 13 to 17 year olds. They will learn basic vocabulary and simple conversation skills. With successful completion, they can apply to return as junior counselors (volunteers) for the following weeks, giving them more (and free) opportunity to learn as well as good experience for transcripts and resumès.

June 10-14 | Newbie (age: 6-12)

This week is designed for 6 to 12 year olds who have not previously attended camp and who have not participated in Club Sign Me Up. This camp will teach the the alphabet, numbers, and some basic vocabulary to establish a foundation for language advancement.

June 17-21 | Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced (age: 6-12)**June 24-28 | Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced (age: 6-12)****July 8-12 | Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced (age: 6-12)****July 15-19 | Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced (age: 6-12)**

Camp Sign Me Up is for six to twelve-year-olds and offers three levels—Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced. You may choose the level you feel is appropriate for your child based on previous attendance in Camp Sign Me Up or Club Sign Me Up. We will evaluate campers and move them to different levels as needed. All the weeks will feature Deaf history and culture, and we will go on one to two field trips each week.

Beginner: This level will cover vocabulary, sentence structure, facial expressions, using space and motion. We will have periods when we turn our voices off.

Intermediate: This level will expand vocabulary and work on non-manual communication and beginning classifiers. We will have days with voices off.

Advanced: These campers will come with a basic conversational ASL. We will continue to build vocabulary and work on facial expressions/eyebrows in grammar, classifiers, multi-meaning words. We will do a story project and will have voices off more than on.

Campers are welcome to attend more than one week. Activities will change each week. There is a \$10 discount for siblings.

Before and after care, 8:30am to 4:45pm, are offered for \$40.00 per week.
