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PRE-SESSION: TASK12 TRAINING INTERPRETERS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS (TIPS)

June 21, 2017

8:30 am-5:00pm

TIPS was developed by TASK12 at the Center for Technical Assistance for Excellence in Special Education (TAESE) at Utah State University. This is an intensive program that begins with an intensive face-to-face training meeting with interpreters, followed by five months studying online modules that aim to improve the performance skills of interpreters and ultimately benefit children and youth who are deaf and hard of hearing. Interpreting skills are assessed before and after the training.

REGISTRATION

- Registration is limited to 250 participants and will close when that number is reached or on May 30, 2017
- Early Bird registration

- Registration includes a Thursday evening reception and lunch and dinner on Friday and Saturday.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Lodging accommodations are available on the UNC campus in [South or North Hall](#). South or North Hall suites typically have two bedrooms (each with two twin beds), a shared bathroom, and a shared living room area. Bed linens, a blanket and pillow, a towel/washcloth, and internet access are provided. An accommodations link will be available when you register for the conference.
- Cost for a room is \$52.25 per night/per person in a shared suite (private bedroom, shared living room and bath). A suite mate will be assigned to you unless otherwise noted on the accommodation registration form. A limited number of triple rooms are also available upon request.
- ADA rooms are available upon request.
- North and South Hall have full kitchens on each wing and a grocery store is located within a short walking distance.
- North and South Hall is located within short walking distance of the University Center, where the conference will be held.
- If you choose to make other arrangements for accommodations, there are hotels several miles from the University Center.

GETTING TO UNC

Denver International Airport (DIA)

- If you will be flying to Colorado, you will fly into DIA. UNC is approximately one hour north.
 - Shuttle service from DIA to the UNC Greeley campus is available through the [Greeley Shuttle](#)
 - Cost: Approximately \$43.00 one way.
 - You will want to specify that your drop off location will be South Hall on the UNC campus.
 - It is recommended that you make reservations ahead of time and use reservation zip code: 80639
 - All transportation services are located on level 5 outside the main terminal of DIA.
