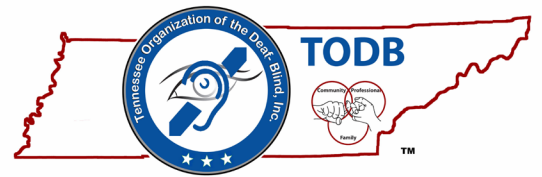

Directions to the Main Library downtown Nashville:

For GPS: use the following address:

615 Church Street, Nashville, TN 37219

- **From the North and West:**

Follow the Interstate to I-40E.

Exit at Church Street and turn left towards downtown.

- **From the South and East:**

Follow the Interstate to I-40W.

Exit at Church Street and turn right toward downtown.

- Drive towards downtown Nashville. The Nashville Main Public Library is located on Church Street, between 6th and 7th Avenues.

- Enter the parking garage from 7th Avenue. Parking is free for the first 1-1/2 hours with the parking stub stamped at the book return counter in the front lobby. Parking is free with handicapped tags or placard.

- Entrance to the library from the parking garage is on Level 4N.

- The DB Expo is in the Conference Center on the First Floor of the library.
