Dr. Sparks is a clinical audiologist and founder of Audiology Outside the Box, an audiologic counseling and (re)habilitation-focused online practice. She also provides cochlear implant, hearing aid, and diagnostic testing services part-time at another clinic. She earned her Doctor of Audiology (Au.D.) degree from Gallaudet University and is currently pursuing a Ph.D. in Hearing, Speech, and Language Sciences at Gallaudet. She has four master's degrees and several graduate certificates, including a M.Ed. in Early Childhood Education and certificates in Infant-Toddler Mental Health and Deaf and Hard of Hearing Infants, Toddlers, and Families: Collaboration and Leadership. Deaf and hard of hearing children and their families, signers, and cochlear implant users are her favorite populations to work with clinically. Dr. Sparks hears with two cochlear implants and communicates in American Sign Language and spoken/written English.
